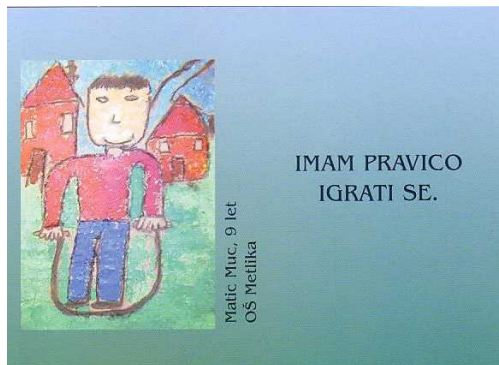

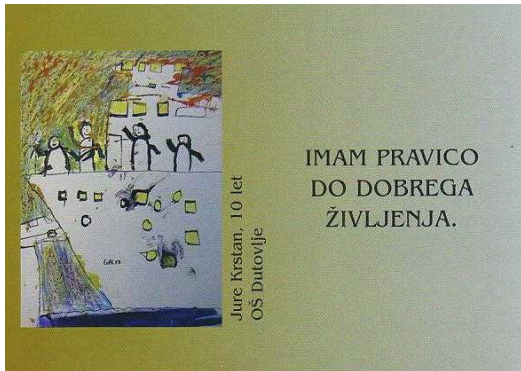

Suggested short didactic activity, suitable for children aged 6 to 10:

GUIDING THE BLIND

Children are divided into pairs. One in each pair is blindfolded and the other is his/her guide. He/she can guide the blind using words, hands or one finger around the classroom. Pairs change roles afterwards. After the activity you can discuss trust, friendship, games or leisure-time related topics.

Suggested short didactic activity, suitable for children aged 6 to 10:

ARROW OF IMAGINATION

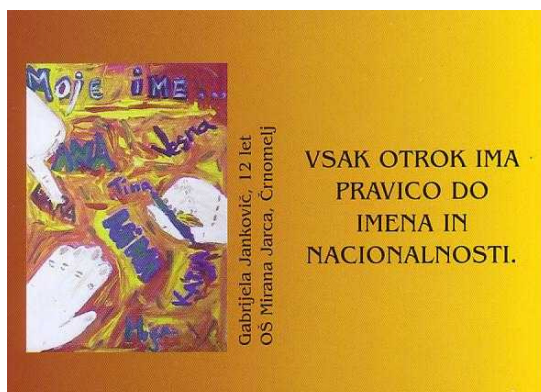
Give children the following instructions. Imagine you are an arrow flying high in the skies. You have been shot down by a giant bow. You fly over the houses, very high. You are gliding fast, firm and reliable. Your way leads you over woods, rivers and hills. Where would you like to land?

Ask children where they have landed in their imagination.

Suggested short didactic activity, suitable for children aged 11 to 15:

WHO OR WHAT AM I, WHO OR WHAT ARE WE?

From color paper cut flower leaves. Everyone takes some leaves of different colors and writes on them answers to the question who he/she is. Make groups of four and discuss what all have in common and what are differences. Glue all flower leaves on one poster to get a class identity.
